



Pre-registration is required. This is a fun competitive program where players will work on incorporating all their skills into all aspects of softball. This is for those in **3rd-6th Grade** **(We will not accept 7th graders unless we do not have enough players to field a team)**. Pickleball is a paddle sport (similar to a racquet sport) that combines elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis.[2] Two or four players use solid paddles made of wood or composite materials to hit a perforated polymer ball, similar to a Wiffle Ball, over a net.

The sport shares features of other racquet sports, the dimensions and layout of a badminton court, and a net and rules somewhat like tennis, with several modifications.




Making Strides


