## Selectmen's Meeting & Workshop Monday, January 11, 2016

Dusvitch stated that he has previously met with the Assessor and did not get any relief. The Board recommended he file an application for abatement. Dusvitch also reviewed two easements existing on the property. Morgan requested that White get a copy of the surrounding property assessments for the Board's review. Dusvitch was dismissed at 4:00 PM.
