

OSSIPPEE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

October 9, 2013

Chairman Ron Adams opened the meeting at 7:00 PM. Members Present: Ron Adams, Bob Pratt, Lynn Clarke and Jean Hansen

Minutes:

Bob Pratt made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 4, 2013 meeting. Jean Hansen seconded the motion and it carried.

Financials:

The Commission reviewed financial statements from August and September.

A-previously approved expenditure for "Get Wild" still not-paid is the New Hampshire Locked Moose Antler Project, Inc. A check for \$500 needs to be sent to NH Locked Moose Antler Project from the Conservation Commission account.

Jean Hansen made a motion that Pat be paid for the time spent moving to the new building by the Conservation Commission, the Planning Board and the Zoning Board of Adjustment. Lynn Clarke seconded the motion and it passed.

Bob Pratt made a motion to pay GMCG \$2,100 for 2013 Water Quality Testing from the Conservation Commission Budget. Jean Hansen seconded the motion and it passed. Next year in January the Commission will ask for a breakdown of how the money will be spent.

Because there is less surplus money for the Lake Host Program, the Commission is raising the Lake Host appropriation to \$2000 in the budget. The budget will be presented to the Selectmen on October 28 at 4:30PM and to the Budget Committee on November 6 at 6:30pm.

Bob Pratt made a motion to spend up to \$150 for a program about bird watching presented by Erik Masterson being scheduled in April or May. Jean Hansen seconded the motion and it passed.
