Roundabout: too expensive since they would have to buy land. 2. Safety factor with line of sight issues with speed and view from hill on Rte. 16. 3. Traffic lights: still safety concern with vision. Even though they are up higher than a roundabout but the biggest deterrent was based on national standards data of the traffic study and number of cars traveling through there verses number of accidents does not warrant a traffic light. 4. NHDOT agreed to install the conduits at this time to reduce tearing up the road again if traffic lights were to be approved. 5. NHDOT agreed to remove any signs that could be blocking views on Route 16.

Ron A., will check with Ellen White, Town Administrator on who will place ad in newspaper for accepting Bids for Windows on the Ossipee clean-up. Clean-up day scheduled for November 2nd with a rain date of November 3rd.
