CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

MEETING MINUTES

April 12, 2017

Minutes were recorded and a Summary transcribed by Laura Nash, Commission Secretary. Revisions to these minutes are noted by *bold/italic* type.

Call to Order: Selectman Representative Sandra "Sam" Martin called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

<u>Welcome New Members</u>: Martin welcomed newly appointed Joe Deighan, Marie McConarty, Julianne Rosiak, Roy Barron (Alternate) and Lorey Pendarvis (Alternate). Ellen White will write a letter of gratitude to former members Ron Adams and Donna Gridley for their hard work, dedication and commitment to the Conservation Commission.

Martin stated first order of business is to elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman for the Conservation Commission.

Roll Call: Marie McConarty, Julianne Rosiak, Roy Barron (Alternate) and Lorey Pendarvis (Alternate). **Absent:** Joe Deighan, Ron Larrivee, Ralph Buchanan, Bruce Parson, and Tim Otterbach.

Martin raised Roy Barron and Lorey Pendarvis to voting status.

Elect a New Chairman: Martin called for any motions for the Chairman position:

Motion by Barron to nominate McConarty as Chairman for the Conservation Commission. No one seconded, motion called dead.

Motion by McConarty to nominate Deighan as Chairman for the Conservation Commission. Rosiak seconded. Martin stated Deighan agreed to be Chairman if nominated. No discussion. A unanimous vote was taken.

Elect a New Vice Chairman: Martin called for any motions for the Vice-Chairman position:

Motion by Barron to nominate McConarty as Vice Chairman for the Conservation Commission. Rosiak seconded. With no more nominations. McConarty accepts the position. No discussion. A unanimous vote was taken.

Martin read a welcome letter to the new members. Martin provided each member with a copy of Robert's Rules, Riggin's Rules and suggested Guidelines for Easement Monitoring. *Martin turned the meeting over to the Vice – Chair, McConarty and stepped down from the Board to the audience.*

Minutes: Review to approve previous Meeting Minutes of March 9, 2017.

Motion by Barron, seconded by Rosiak, to hold meeting minutes of March 9, 2017 until next CC meeting on May 10, 2017, to allow existing members who were present at that meeting, approve the minutes. No discussion. **All voted in favor, motion passed.**

Guest: Justin Cloutier and Jessica Cole of Sumner Brook Herbal & Fish Hatchery here to update the Commission:

1. Get Wild: Event is scheduled for July 8, 2017. Cloutier explained the event to the new members as a way of promoting the fish hatchery to the Town's people. Board members organize and work the event which allows children 12 and under to catch one fish free, there's food, entertainment and

- information tables' setup for conservation, wildlife, etc... Rosiak is to speak with Fish & Game on participating in the event demonstrating wildlife, pelts, etc...

- Maintenance of Forest Cut Monitoring/Management: Motion made by Barron requesting Bob Boyd attend the next Conservation Commission meeting on May 10, 2017. Rosiak seconded. Barron would like to discuss the management of Town Forest, as well as, other properties. No further discussion. A unanimous vote was taken.
- Unauthorized Public Notice: Rosiak asked why none of the existing Conservation Commission members came to tonight's meeting. Martin instructed Nash to officially submit for the minutes and informed the members of an unauthorized public notice. The unauthorized public notice was not submitted or approved by the Board of Selectmen, the Conservation Commission secretary and was not voted on by the Conservation Commission members. The notice was posted at the Town Hall on Monday and a subsequent notice was posted at the Post Office on Tuesday afternoon. McConarty read the notice:

"Conservation Commission Meeting

The next meeting of the Conservation Commission will April 19th (instead of April 12th) to allow time for new Commission members to be notified and to be sworn in by the Town Clerk at Town Hall. The meeting will be at 7:00 at the Freight House."

Martin suggested per E. White that Nash send a letter to the current members, not in attendance, informing them the meeting was held on April 12th as scheduled and posted.

A **Motion** made by Barron to send a letter to the existing Commission members notifying them the meeting was held on April 12th as scheduled and posted and there will be no Conservation Commission meeting on the April 19th. The next Conservation Commission meeting is on May 10, 2017 as scheduled for 7:00 pm at the Freight House. Rosiak seconded the motion. No further discussion. A unanimous vote was taken.

Pendarvis question the following email request:

• Nash explained the history behind this email received from Susan Wiley of the Carroll County Farm about possibly putting a conservation easement on sections of the Carroll County Farm property. At the previous meeting it was determined Tim Otterbach would approach Green Mountain Conservation Group and Ron Adams would approach Dan Hole Pond Watershed Trust of possibly purchasing some of the land for Conservation Easement. After brief discussion, Motion made by Barron to send a letter declining Ms. Wiley's request for a conservation easement. Rosiak seconded. No discussion. A unanimous vote was taken.

Adjourn:

Motion made by Barron, seconded by Rosiak, to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor, motion passed.
