

WEST OSS�PEE FIRE PRECINCT

To the inhabitants of the West Ossipee Precinct in the County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote in precinct affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the West Ossipee Central Station on Route 16, in said Town of Ossipee on Saturday, January 10, 2009 beginning at ten o'clock in the forenoon (10:00am) to act on the following articles:

Article I:

To elect all necessary precinct officers for the ensuing year as follows: to choose one commissioner for a term of three (3) years; one clerk for a term of one (1) year; one treasurer for a term of one (1) year; one moderator for a term of one (1) year.

Article II:

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$373,000 for the purchase and construction of a new fire station on Jewell Hill Road. Such sum to be raised by the issuance of serial bonds or notes not to exceed \$373,000 under and in compliance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33:1 et seq., as amended) and to authorize the Commissioners to issue and negotiate such bonds or other notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon and to take such other actions as may be necessary to effect the issuance, negotiation, sale and delivery of such bonds or notes as shall be in the best interests of the West Ossipee Fire Precinct and furthermore to raise and appropriate the sum of \$52,000 for the first year's payment for that purpose. The Commissioners recommend this appropriation. The budget committee recommends this appropriation. (2/3 ballot vote required).

Article III:

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Four Thousand One Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$354,130) for general precinct operations. (Majority vote required).

Article IV:

To see if the precinct will vote to discontinue the Water Supply Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund. Said funds, if any, and accumulated interest to date of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the precinct's general fund. (Majority vote required)

Article V:

To see if the precinct will vote to discontinue the Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund. Said funds, if any, and accumulated interest to date of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the precinct's general fund. (Majority vote required)

Article VI:

To see if the precinct will vote to accept the provisions of RSA 33:7 providing that any village precinct at an annual meeting may adopt an article authorizing indefinitely, until specific rescission of such authority, the Commissioners to issue tax anticipation notes? (Majority vote required)

Article VII:

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate (Fifty Thousand Dollars) \$50,000 for the purchase and installation of an exhaust system to be installed at the new Jewell Hill Fire Station to be funded by a grant with no money raised through taxation. If a grant is not received, this article will be null and void. (Majority vote required)

Article VIII:

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate (Eleven Thousand Dollars) \$11,000 for the purchase and installation of a generator at the new Jewell Hill Fire Station to funded by a grant with no money to be raised through taxation. If a grant is not received, this article will be null and void. (Majority vote required)

Article IX:

To see if the precinct will vote to raise and appropriate (Fifteen Thousand Dollars) \$15,000 for the purchase and installation of an extractor for the cleaning of firefighter gear to be funded by a grant with no money to be raised through taxation. If a grant is not received, this article will be null and void. (Majority vote required)

Article X:

To transact any other business which may legally come before the meeting.
