The Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington D.C. was conceived by Jan Scruggs who served in Vietnam from 1969-1970. He wanted the memorial to acknowledge and recognize the service and sacrifice of all who served in Vietnam. Designer Maya Ling created an abstract focus for the nation's grief with two simple black-granite walls, engraved with the names of 58,156 Americans killed and 1,291 Americans missing in Vietnam. The memorial was officially dedicated on November 13, 1982 and is seen by 1.5 million people each year-the most visited monument in Washington D.C.

The MOVING WALL was conceived by John Devitt, Gerry Haver and Norris Shears, all Vietnam veterans who lived in California. They wanted to create a replica of the memorial that could come to people who could not travel to Washington D.C. The MOVING WALL was first displayed in October of 1984 in Tyler, Texas.

During the last 24 years, the MOVING WALL has visited every state in the union as well as numerous other countries as millions of people have visited this memorial. As John Devitt has said, "...a visit to the Wall is a profoundly moving and human experience. Anyone who has visited the Wall is part owner, for each person has left a little of themselves and taken a little of what they found there."

The THREE SERVICEMEN sculpture was created by Frederick Hart and unveiled as part of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial on November 8, 1984.

The VIETNAM WOMEN'S MEMORIAL was dedicated on November 11, 1993. It was designed by Diane Carlson Evans who was a nurse in Vietnam in 1968-1969.

Together, these three memorials represent the valor, spirit, sacrifice, dedications and patriotism of the millions of men and women who served during the Vietnam War.
