

Selectmen's Meeting
05/03/10

Chairman Harry C. Merrow called the meeting to order at 4:15 PM. Present were: Harry C. Merrow, E. Morton Leavitt, and Martha B. Eldridge, Town Administrator, who recorded the minutes. Kathleen M. Maloney was absent.

Leavitt made a motion to approve the minutes of 4-26-10. Merrow seconded. The motion carried.

The Work-log from the Highway Department for the week ending 05-01-10 was received.

Merrow stated that there is a meeting scheduled for Wednesday at 3:30 PM with Kathleen Maloney and Dave Babson to discuss the taxing of the County Farm. Leavitt stated that he would like to attend this meeting also.

The staff received a thank you note from U.S. Census Bureau for their help with providing the space needs for the program.

Costantino Real Estate, LLC submitted an application for website link to the Town's website. Merrow made a motion to approve this application. Leavitt seconded. The motion carried.

An Intent to Excavate was received from Frederick W. Heckel, IV to excavate 380,000 cubic yards from their pit located on Rte. 28, Map 19 Lots 119 & 120.

Merrow made a motion to approve this intent. Leavitt seconded. The motion carried.

The Board received a copy of "The New Hampshire Municipal Conservation Fund Guidebook". This will be available at the town hall.

The Board received a revised copy of the State Highway Block Grant Aid notice. The town will see a reduction in funds amounting to \$98.70.

An application for an abatement was received from Arthur & Cindy Ferrero, Map 1 Lot 3. After review of the documentation received, the assessor recommended denial of this application. Merrow made a motion to deny this application. Leavitt seconded. The motion carried.

An application for an abatement was received from Leonard & Anne Wetherbee Map 50 Lot 6. After review of the documentation received, the assessor recommended denial of this application. Merrow made a motion to deny this application. Leavitt seconded. The motion carried.

An application for an abatement was received from WWS Campground, LLC Map 5 Lot 28.3. After review of the documentation received, the assessor recommended denial of this application. Merrow made a motion to deny this application. Leavitt seconded. The motion carried.

The Board received three notifications of "Ossipee Statewide DWI Hunter Patrols" have been officially approved.

The Board received documents to be signed for the E9-1-1 Data Capture for the Town. The Board requested copies for each of them to review prior to signing. Eldridge agreed to copy them for the Board.

The Board received a notice of a Public Hearing with the Planning Board on the 18th of May, 2010 to discuss a site plan review for NH Electric Co-op for a proposal for telecommunications structure and shelter.

Merrow stated that the cupola that was on the OCC building appears to be missing and asked Eldridge to look into this matter.

The Board agreed to meet with Brad Harriman on Friday at 9:00 am to discuss the recent bids for repair work at the town hall.

The Board agreed that Eldridge should contact the Union to start the process of negotiation for the next contract.

The Board asked Eldridge to start preparing the specs for the Ambulance Contract.

Leavitt stated that the notice in reference to milfoil will be sent out to the Bass Clubs this week.

Leavitt stated that legislature has been passed that does not allow towns to merge lots together.

Mark Bellaud, of Aquatic Control Technology, Inc. came in to meet with the Board in reference to the treatment of milfoil. The Board has stated that they don't want any treatment until the fall. Bellaud informed the Board of the process that needs to take place prior to any treatment. Applications, hearings, and notification of the abutters are necessary before the treatment of milfoil takes place. The request for a permit must be filed. How this process is going to be paid for was discussed. It appears that the cost can be covered by the Town. Bellaud stated that this can all be done by Aquatic Control Tech., Inc. when the contract is signed. The Board requested a certificate of insurance from them. Bellaud stated that this would be forwarded to Eldridge tomorrow. Merrow made a motion to go ahead with the project. Leavitt seconded. The motion carried.

The Board asked Eldridge to call Cliff Cabral to see if he can come in to meet with them to discuss the pulling of the milfoil after the treatment is done.

The Public Input session of the meeting was opened.

Being no public input, Merrow made a motion to adjourn. Leavitt seconded. The motion carried.
