Truffle acoustic trio consists of David Bailey (bass, vocals), Ned Chase (mandolin, guitar, lap steel & vocals), and Dave Gerard (vocals, acoustic resonator guitars). These three musicians have been creating music together since 1986. They have performed in all but ten states across the U.S., playing as many as 275 shows in one year. Truffle has achieved widespread popularity by headlining many respected venues as well as sharing the stage with international acts as Little Feat, Phish, The Band, Dave Matthew's Band, David Lindley, and Blues Traveler to name only a few.

EC & the Darrellicks – Tuesday, July 24th

Ellen Carlson has been rocking out on the fiddle in the New England area for many years. She was determined to pull her brother, Darrell, and his rich, powerful voice out of the woodwork, so they formed "EC & the Darrellicks" with some old band buddies. This group is a conglomerate of sorts. Grabbing Paul Stowell on the drums (who Ellen played with in former regional award-winning country and rhythm and blues bands) and Chris Pimental on bass (from the iconic bluegrass/roots band "Lunch at the Dump" where Ellen did a short stint playing fiddle) Ellen and Darrell formed EC & The Darrellicks. The band has a large repertoire that includes rockabilly, country, bluegrass, rock and western swing. For added spice, all band members sing and contribute songs from many styles. EC & the Darrellicks have a lot to offer.
