Article # 1 To elect all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year as follows: to choose one (1) Selectman for a term of three (3) years; two (2) Zoning Board of Adjustment members for a term of three (3) years; one (1) Library Trustee for a term of three (3) years; one (1) Supervisor of the Checklist for a term of six (6) years; one (1) Trustee of Trust Funds for a term of three (3) years; one (1) Water/Sewer Commissioner for a term of three (3) years; two (2) Budget Committee Members for a term of three (3) years; two (2) Planning Board members for a term of three (3) years; one (1) Cemetery Trustee for a term of two (2) years; one (1) Cemetery Trustee for a term of three (3) years; one Treasurer for a term of three (3) years.
