Case \#457 Robert Elliott, property located at 107 Hodsdon Shore Rd, Tax Map 73, Lot 115. Applicant is seeking a Variance from Article 6.4.1a for the front setback.
He explained that this old mobile home was his parents, but now he and his sister own it. They want to replace it with a stick built home, which will be farther back from the road than the present home. It has a working septic system that can be replaced if necessary.
