

Selectmen's Work Session & Non-Public Session
Monday, July 22, 2019

The following meeting was held in the upstairs conference room at Town Hall. Present were Selectmen Sandra Martin, Martha Eldridge, and Susan Simpson, and Ellen White, Town Administrator, who recorded the minutes.

Chairman Martin called the meeting to order at 3:08 PM.

Review of Red Folders, Accounts Payable and Payroll Manifests:

The Accounts Payable & Payroll Manifest, Red Folder, and Water & Sewer Red Folder were reviewed.

Brief discussion took place on the agenda items listed including the Sign Permit Application for 1805 Route 16, the zoning complaint filed on 2305 Route 16, and the White Pond Boat Ramp Administrative Order received from NH DES.

Non-Public Session:

Also present was Kellie Skehan, Town Clerk/Tax Collector. Martin polled the Board for a Non-Public Session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II (c) for a tax matter at 3:31 PM. Martin answered yes, Simpson answered yes, and Eldridge answered yes. Martin made a motion to adjourn the Non-Public Session at 3:41 PM. Eldridge seconded. A unanimous vote was taken. Skehan was dismissed.

Steve McConarty, Zoning Enforcement Officer, entered at 3:46 PM. Martin questioned the status of the patriotic colored cargo container on the Agape Ministries property. McConarty responded that a certified letter went out in the mail last week requesting the removal of the cargo container. He also stated that property owner Kevin Straughan is in favor of removing the container.

McConarty requested additional time for issuing his response to the zoning complaint for 2305 Route 16.

Discussion took place on the Employee of the Year Award. The Board agreed that consideration should be given to candidate's that may have received the award in the past. Martin suggested an anonymous box for nominations.

Being no further input, the work session adjourned. Adjourned at 4:00 PM.
