

Selectmen's Work Session Monday, June 28, 2021

The following meeting was held in the upstairs conference room at Town Hall. Present were Selectmen Martha Eldridge, Susan Simpson and Jonathan Smith. Matt Sawyer Jr., Town Administrator was also present, and recorded the minutes.

Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 3:00 PM

Discussion:

There was light conversation. At 3:05 PM, Smith made a motion to enter a nonpublic session under RSA 91-A:3, IIc for reputational risk. Simpson seconded and a roll call vote was taken: Smith -Yes, Simpson -YES, Eldridge -Yes.

At 3:25 PM, Smith made a motion to re-enter the public session. Simpson seconded and the vote passed 3-0. Smith made a motion to seal the nonpublic minutes. Eldridge seconded and the vote passed 3-0.

Smith began discussing the possibility of skipping some Mondays for more of a bi-weekly approach for the summer. There was a discussion and consensus to skip the following dates as long as nothing pressing emerged for agenda items: July 19, August 2, August 16 and August 30.

At 3:45 PM, Simpson made a motion to enter another nonpublic session under RSA 91-A:3, IIa to discuss personnel. Smith seconded and a roll call vote was taken: Smith -YES, Simpson -YES, Eldridge -YES.

At 3:57 PM, Simpson made a motion to return to the public meeting. Eldridge seconded and the vote passed 3-0. Simpson made a motion to seal the minutes from the second nonpublic session. Eldridge seconded and the vote passed 3-0.

At 4:00 PM, TJ presented several quotes for the street paving. There was a brief discussion and Smith motioned to accept Allstate Paving's bid and use them for the paving. Simpson seconded and the vote passed 3-0.

Being no further input, the work session recessed until 4:15 PM in the gym.
