

Selectmen's Work Session Monday, December 12, 2022

The following meeting was held in the upstairs conference room at Town Hall. Present were Selectmen Susan Simpson, Jonathan Smith and Martha Eldridge. Matt Sawyer Jr., Town Administrator was also present, and recorded the minutes. Public Works Director TJ Eldridge was present.
