Practices: Dates & Time TBD


Ages: 12U & 10U (8-12 years old *Age as of January 1, 2023*)



Intro to Safe Babysitting by Safe Sitter® is a program designed for students in grades 6-8 who are interested in learning how to safely care for children. Students learn tips to manage behavior that will help them stay in control of themselves and the children in their care. Students also learn the ages and stages of child development, as well as practicing diapering.

The Summer Fun Club is a day camp for elementary school aged children that are entering the first grade
through those entering seventh grade. Children <u>must</u> have completed kindergarten <u>and</u> turn six years old by
September 30, 2022. There are no exceptions to this requirement. First Day of Camp is Monday, June 27th.
There will be no camp on Monday, July 4th & Tuesday, July 5th. We will offer some of our usual favorite field
trips and add a few new trips as well. There will be times where wearing facemasks will be required including
on the bus and at any location that requires masks to be worn. By registering your child, you are agreeing to
adhere to the policies in place. We will be accepting a maximum of 65 participants.

Pickleball

No pre-registration is required. This is a drop-in program. Pickleball is a paddle sport (similar to a racquet sport) that combines elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis.[2] Two or four players use solid paddles made of wood or composite materials to hit a perforated polymer ball, similar to a Wiffle Ball, over a net.

The sport shares features of other racquet sports, the dimensions and layout of a badminton court, and a net and rules somewhat like tennis, with several modifications.
