- Title: Counselor In Training (CIT) – Summer Fun Club
Non-paying position
- Qualifications: Applicants must be dependable, enjoy working with children, and be willing to listen and learn but also take an active role when necessary. Prior experience working with children is preferred. Specialized skills in the following areas are helpful: special events, arts and crafts, sports, games and working with school aged youth. Must be at least 13 years of age. 14 and older is preferred.
- Responsibilities: Works under the general supervision of the Fun Club Director, Senior Group Leader, and Group Leaders.
- Be a positive role model to campers.
- Must adhere to all guidelines outlined in the staff manual
- Responsible for the maintenance of the facility, supplies and equipment
- Work Hours: Must be available to work on average at least 3 days a week.
Hours may vary by week but may not exceed 40 hours per week.

Counselor in Training Objectives:

The Counselor in Training program is a volunteer position and participants receive training and hands on experience working with children in a recreation setting. CIT's gain valuable skills that they often use in future work and school environments. Please be advised that the program is not designed to be used as a childcare option. It is a training environment with responsibilities. Applicants should be mature enough to act appropriately and must be able to receive and follow through with directions given. Please note that not all applicants are accepted for the program.
