Youth Mid-Winter Programs

Teen Court Sports:

Join Slayd on Sundays at the town hall from 6:30 to 8:30 for whiffle ball, dodgeball, and other exciting games. This program is for kids who are 12 and older.

Little Pro's Basketball:

Tuesdays from 3:30 to 4:30 at the Ossipee Town Hall Starts: March 24th and ends on May 5th. (No Program 4/23)

February School Vacation Activities:

- *Ski with the Ossipee Police Department*
Monday, February 24, from 8:30 to 5:00. Pick up and drop off will be at the town hall. The kids will be bussed over to King Pine for a fun day of skiing or snowboarding. This is for children 12 and older. Preregistration is required and ends on February 20th. Cost is \$35. Rentals are an additional \$25 (\$70 total). If you have a season pass, cost is \$15.
- *Snow Tubing at King Pine*
Tuesday, February 25, we'll be heading over to King Pine from noon to 2:00 for two hours of tubing. Drop-off is at 9:00 and pick-up is at 4:00 at the Ossipee Town Hall. Please make sure that your child has appropriate clothing, water bottle, and a lunch. Children must be 6 and older to attend. Pre-registration is required and ends on February 20th. A minimum of 10 children is needed for this program to run. A maximum of 25 children will be allowed. Cost is \$25.
- *Community Barn Dance*
Wednesday, February 26, at town hall from 5:30 to 7:30. Come join us for a fun family friendly dance at the town hall.
- *Family Gras*
Thursday, February 27th, at town all starting at 2:00 for an all ages, family event that will include classic Mardi Gras music and stories.

REFIT: Adult Fitness Class:
